INTRODUCTION

Description

Summary

The final proposal is the result from weeks of interviews, meetings, workshop and survey. The objective of the project is to connect people with nature and attract people from the city centre. Our proposal includes, amongst other things, to add new buildings, new offices, places for activities, rest, recreation, agroforestry, eco cabins and new parking etc.

We have for some weeks been working on a design proposal to establish a link between Angered and Hammarkullen. We want to do by proposing new buildings, offices, places of activities, rest, recreation, agroforestry, eco cabins, parking amongst other things.

In the beginning and during the process we have been in contact with many different people, organizations, NGO: s and the municipality to create a better picture of the area. We have gone to meetings, interviewed people in Angered, Hammarkullen and in the Gothenburg Centre, met with students from Angered high school and listened to their ideas. All this information, we have tried to process to form the basis of our design.

We propose new homes between Angered and Hammarkullen, close to the tramline. There will be a variety of types of housing, different number of floors, offices, and, if possible, restaurants and shops in the ground floor apartments.

There will be space for rest and activities and the possibility of growing and picking apples from the fruit trees. Along the tram line there is space for agroforestry and we connect the existing paths and are creating new ones.


We want to make Lärjeån café and gardens more visible for people visiting and people living in Angered. We have therefore worked with elements that will inspire people go to the café. Close to Lärjeån we propose to have eco-cabins for people to enjoy.

When visitors come to Angered by tram and / or by car, our hope is that they experience and can see many exciting things that makes them want to stay and explore what he area has to offer.



BACKGROUND History



1984

A visionary exhibition 'Trädgård till nytta och nöje'

A visionary exhibition at the Blue site in Angered called 'Trädgård till nytta och nöje' ('Garden for the benefit and pleasure') that created great interest with about 60 000 visitors.

2000

Operations started with limited financial resources

Operations started in earnest, but the Foundation 'Lärjeån Café & Gardens' was formed with very limited financial resources.

In this connection, the association - Världsbyn was established with visions of building a "village" of buildings, businesses and plantations with elements from all over the world.

2006

Limited finacial resouces made the operations become "choppy"

The business had three talented gardeners and the garden had been well maintained, but the business did not go around economically which led to the Foundation eventually gave up. Since then, the operations become "choppy" followed by a period with decay and vandalism of the garden.

2010

Way Out !! started to build the garden in a good way again

When interest later requested, in 2010 it was awarded by the Way Out!! - cooperative responsibility, which today operates and develops the business further. With slightly stronger resources than the incumbent players in Lärjeån Café & Gardens, Way Out!! break a bad trend and started to build the garden in a good way again.

2011 - 2013

Stadlandet Gothenburg has been carried out within Utveckling Nordost




BACKGROUND


Demography











Compared with the city center of Göteborg, Angered is a suburb area famous for Million Programme, providing homes for around 60,000 residents. As the living price is relevant cheaper than city center, low income population and immigrants choose Angered to be their homes.

Population grows year by year in Angered, faster than that in city center of Göteborg. Population frame in Angered is a little different that in city center because of large amount of teenagers. Young people could be rich labour resources to Angered, meanwhile, could be a dangerous group if lack of their mental and physical needs.

In Angered, numbers of immigrants are much more than those in city center of Göteborg. Many of immigrants come from Muslin world like Iraq and Iran, other part of Europe like Finland and Poland. Immigrants bring abundant culture and vivid atmosphere to Angered, but sometimes are misunderstood by others because of the sensationalizing by media, according to some inhabitants.

BACKGROUND **Utveckling Nordost**

Utveckling Nordost (Development North East) found that the multicultural background in northeast gothenburg has its potentials to develop urban agriculture and green business, since residents here have more knowledge and experiences to do farming, animal raising, handicraft, etc.

According to the materials from Utveckling Nordost and our meeting with Dan Melander and Pernilla (Vägen ut!), the development hub in Lärjeån will have these functions:

- Sustainable economy and green business development
- Product processing
- Academy for agroforestry
- Eco-tourism (Eco-cabins)
- Education, Research and utilization
- Center for cultural and creative industries
- Forest Laboratory (construction, energy, design)
- IT network between city and country
- Outdoor educational forum











CONTEXT

The Site




The site is located in the southwest part of Angered, linking the tram line between Störa and Angered Center. Though Angered is seen as suburb part in Göteborg, it takes around 20 minutes by tram from city center to Angered Center, which is actually accessible to citizens. Unfortunately, reality is that citizens know little about Angered and its attractive point.


Facing these realistic conditions, our task is to find out the opportunities and challenges of Angered. As Million Programme has developed several decades, Angered has large number of housing. Except for industry set in Angered, the whole northern part of Göteborg relies on the only center - Angered center to provide services. Different from this, services in city center are more reachable. The neighborhood community serves citizens more choices.

However, large amounts of natural resources is a chance for Angered. With relevant high density living in city center, citizens desire for nature. If Angered can make good use of its nature, it will be a treasure.


Angered shares teenagers as the future powerful group, while city center is troubled for unbalanced aging population and lacking of labour resources.







CONTEXT Ecological Analysis




Natural resources of Göteborg is concentrated in and around the northern part. Angered has a lot of forests and water resources in the alpine areas. Birds and animals like to stay in these areas so that observers are willing to climb up the mountains and cross the streams.

As most high density areas are concentrated in city center of Göteborg, urban problems for example, heat island effect, can be produced easily. To cool down the city and maintain sustainability of urban area, natural resources in suburb has to be protected carefully. For aspects, the United Nations and Swedish political departments pay close attention to protect environment in Angered.

Let us know more about the near environment of Angered.

Next to the site, a Preservation for rare animals like mussel and salmon is set in Lärjeån Valley. To the north of the site, there is a bird preservation. Meanwhile, the site is in the range of water resources preservation of Göteborg. Therefore, to consider a suitable design for this urban-rural hub, nature has to be one of the most important factors.

Additionally, human activated areas are always barriers for nature. Similarly, nature is a barrier for development in a way. In the past, human had gone through the path to combat with nature, but the outcome very little, at least to make human understand the limitation of natural resources. At the process of exploring sustainable future, from this project, our team has to think deeply about how to develop and design the site but make it as a friendly transition spot between nature and




CONTEXT Site Analysis






The site is very special for the whole northern part of Göteborg with its strategic significance for the urban-rural hub. It means that Angered center is officially focus for the development of Göteborg.

There are several residences near the site, which means that the design have to consider nearby residents' needs. Industrial areas are surrounded the tram line, which is convenient for the employees working in the factories. In the Lärjeån Valley, lots of natural resources and typology can be used as function of recreation and landscape, and some areas in the Lärjeån Valley are used for farming.

ANALYSIS Conclusion

For Angered, opportunities always work with challenges. Opportunities hides in initiatives from multi-cultural skills like handicrafts and agriculture which local Swedish lack of, also in resources of nature. Challenges lies in how to organize the attractive points together to make mix-functional area, which can provide different and special kinds of services only in Angered.




Firstly, for residents in Angered, they are willing strongly to break isolation from the urban center. When citizens can only by tram or spend a lot of time on taking bus to a place they know little, Angered lacks of the attractive point for them. If natural resources are seen to be a developing point, as the entrance of Lärjeån valley, facilities and activities spots in Lärjeån cafe have to be upgraded. Especially, for those who want to visit Lärjeån cafe from Angered center, it is hard to find their way.

Making good use of natural resources, it will produce a lot of chances for creating diverse recreational spots for human. Nowadays, there are different kinds of activities in forest of Angered. In Lärjeån valley, near the site, there is a horse riding basement and camel farm, which serves people enjoyable moments with animals. However, northeast part is developing so that facilities and infrastructure are not that well-organized. One of our task is find out how to link the existing infrastructure with existing and new facilities to form a good leisure area.

To maintain the natural resources, planning preservation is not enough. Because sustainability not just stays in ecology or biodiversity, social interaction and economic growth have to be thought about. To sustain the relationship between human and nature, ecological resilience should be the foundation of development. To analyse the whole Göteborg, green corridor is connected towards city center. 



Economic incentives are one of the most important consideration to this area, to increase more jobs with improving life quality, different factors have to be integrated on the foundation of existing infrastructure and advantages of local residents.

Attractive points of Angered may be the large amount of natural resources and potential handmade skills from multi-culture residents. As functions in the site are isolated and simple, lacking of activities and alive atmosphere, tram line between Storå and Angered centum stop gives the first impression for visitors and residents. Our proposal concentrates on creating mix-function neighborhoods, innovating some industry into leisure spaces as new meeting points and adding in-between green to make livable environment to densify the area along the tram line.

Meanwhile, to preserve nature and reduce the influences from human society, agroforestry is an useful transition, which provide potential for ecological restoration between them.

Although Lärjeån Cafe is chosen to be one important part of the development hub, and its location seems very close to Angered Centrum in Google map. It is not just that easy to find the way to go there when you are being in Angered Centrum. The gap is existing. According to our investigation, we think that many people mainly get off from Angered Centrum station and enter into their destinations like the shopping mall, then stop moving further. Besides, the atmosphere near the large parking lot seem so deadly, which may be one reason that people don't walk further and see the cafe in Lärjeån. Even to people who come to visit Lärjeån Cafe on purpose, by car or by public transportation, it is also difficult because there is no guiding equipment showing way to the cafe.





To solve those problems, our main task is using some design methods to connect Angered Centrum and Lärjeån Cafe. These are some proposals we have designed:




1. Greenhouses

Greenhouse is a good way to cultivate vegetables and plants. Since this location is near the shopping mall, the high school and the parking lot, why not combine them with some other functions like office, boutique, cafe or tea house, etc.










2. Wooden walls & billboards

According to the newest design by Frigående Arkitekter, wooden walls will be used to build an new entrance for Lärjeån Cafe. By using the same way to build walls and billboards alongside the roads, an 'entrance' feeling would be extending which may let the visitors easier to find the cafe.









3. Fruit trees alley

From our meeting with Pernilla (Vägen ut!), she suggested that some fruit trees could be planted alongside the roads. Since the staffs of Lärjeån Cafe had planed to plant trees inside the garden, why not extend to outside and create a fruit trees alley, then let people to enjoy the beauty of these trees and even pick some fruits from them.






5. Parking lot

Parking lot for Lärjeån Cafe is removed from the previous location to the roadside, to fulfill the requirement from Pernilla (Vägen ut!), new parking lot can provide enough place for about 30 cars.


Since the layout of Lärjeån Cafe & Gardens have designed by Frigående Arkitekter, Pernilla (Vägen ut!) said that she want most of that design could be preserved. 


6 & 7. Reception & eco-cabins

The reception for eco-cabins is placed in the previous location of parking lot within the garden, which is a good link with Lärjeån Cafe and the eco-cabins and services could be provided for guests from two sides.

Eco-cabins are placed far from Lärjeån Cafe, in a more tranquil environment facing a great view of Lärjeån Valley. There is also a new parking lot near these eco-cabins, and agroforestry would be planted near them to show its beauty and function.

1 Agroforestry


Making use of the complicated structure to protect the farmland from insects pest and adjust the microclimate locally, agroforestry can balance the relationship between nature and human agricultural activities, also being a transition for both of them.


Agroforestry provides services for many aspects. Firstly, provide shade and wind. Secondly, Reduce water evaporation and stress on animals; increase agricultural production. Thirdly, control pests. Fourthly, improve soil permeability and reduce flooding.

2 Mini Golf


Recreational area serves open spaces, clean air and leisure spaces for local people and visitors. Though the site has a big residence, its shortage lies in the inadequate facilities surrounded. If residents want to exercise or relax, their only choice is the forest. However, as the forest is so big, it takes a long time for them to climb up hills to reach activities' spots. The best way to solve the problem is to add a small leisure spot where is flat and with good view near the residences and Angered Center. Passersby will naturally be the guards for people playing in the spot. Meanwhile, players can also upgrade the lively atmosphere and attract walkers.

Floor heights


Diagram showing the buildings and there different heights. Access to sun and noise has been consider when dividing heights. Note that no sun study has been made, because of lack of time, but earlier experience have been used to divide the heights.

Functions

The area has been divided into different functions, where offices are placed to protect from the apartments from noise. The new villas are planned to be an extension of the existing villa area. The reception is placed to attract people coming with the tram, planning to visit the Eco centre. We propose that the existing small industry could be transformed, in a few years into green house and art galleries.

Mix use

The area should be pedestrian friendly with diverse ownership, heights, colours, material and if there is a need also shops and/or restaurants in the ground floor. Shops and restraurants should be placed together, concentrated, and form a "shopping street" if possible. Where this could be need to be investigated more.





In 3-5 years we propose that the empty plot close to the small industry could be transformed into area for apartments. And the area close to Storås tram station can be built.

In 5-10 years we imagine the possibility to that much of the area are transformed, with reservation that the existing small industry are still in use.

In 10-20 years the area close to Rösered, west of Spadegatan, can be developed with both housing and offices.


